Citizenship Teacher/Tutor

Class takes place on Sunday afternoons from 2-5 PM for 10-week sessions. A lead teacher provides civics-based ESL instruction, with support from tutors who work with adult students 1:1 on interview skills.

ESL Class Teacher

Teach a small class of adult ESL students for an 8-week class session. Classes are taught 2x/week from 9:30-11:30 AM or from 6-8 PM. We also need teaching assistants and substitutes. We provide additional training and a curriculum to use.

Flexible Small Group ESL Tutor

Work with a small group of adult ESL students on their English Language skills. Tutoring sessions take place in public locations, and can be scheduled during the evenings, weekends, or virtually.

Rising Up Afterschool Support

Provide support to our team of afterschool tutors on Tuesdays and Thursdays from 2:30-4:30 PM. We have three school sites and provide afterschool tutoring to children in grades 1-5.



Events and Outreach Team

Help us share the word about our programs by joining our Event Planning Committee or Outreach Team. The Events Committee meets once a month and coordinates our annual events. Our Outreach Team represents IH at various community events and tabling fairs.
